Regulations Racer Bikes Cup 2009 (English - short version)

E1. Introduction

This is a short version of the Racer Bikes Cup regulations in English. The detailed regulation is in German and French.

The Racer Bikes Cup is the National Race Series of Switzerland. All races are Class 1 or Class 2 and we use the UCI rules to manage our races.

E2. Riders

The Racer Bikes Cup has categories for

- Elite Men and Elite Women (Class1 or Class 2)
- junior men, junior women, amateurs
- fun-riders (without a licence)
- Kids (from 6 16 years of age)

A Newcomer will stay a Newcomer for the whole season and he/she will start in the normal category (fun and kids) but there will be a separate result list for these riders.

We take the best 4 results of the races 1 - 7 (the 3 weakest results don't count) as well as the final race in Muttenz. If two riders have the same amount of point at the end, the better result of the last race (Muttenz) will decide.

Licence categories

We take the best 4 results of the races 1-7 (the 3 weakest results don't count) as well as the final race in Muttenz. If two riders have the same amount of point at the end, the better result of the last race (Muttenz) will decide.
